Registration closes July 1, 2022. We cannot accommodate walk-ins

- A non-refundable \$100 per person deposit is due at time of registration.
- One-day-only registration (\$83) is not refundable.
- After you register, you may log in to your account and make payments as well as add information such as flight arrival and departure times.
- Remaining balance will be automatically charged to your credit card July 1, 2022.

Family/Group Registrations:

- Everyone is welcome: All members of the Franciscan family (1st, 2nd and 3rd orders), friends and families of Franciscans, and anyone interested in celebrating our Jubilee.
- Family members may attend, but there are no programs for children. You can pay for a full registration per person (includes meal plan) or provide meals on your own.
- Group registration is allowed. You may register multiple persons (2 or more) on one registration form, so that a couple, a family or group can register all at once.

How do I register?

- Provide two (2) <u>Emergency Contact Numbers</u> (different from registrant's number). Give person's name and relationship to registrant.

- → Upon request we can supply Braille or Large print versions of schedules for vision impairment.

- → Please let us know if you will be bringing wheelchair, walker, scooter, oxygen, service animal or C-Pap machine (Distilled water will be provided for C-Pap machines upon request).

- <u>Travel Information</u>: You may return to the registration website to provide travel information.
