- A. Francis regarded this event as a "great secret"
 - 1. We have no eye witness testimony!
 - 2. Notification of this miracle was not sent until Francis had died
 - 3. As more biographies were written (Celano, Bonaventure, Companions) the details began to be supplied.
- B. Why, then, do we feel that we know the story?
 - 1. Art has played a major role in transmitting the story
 - `a. This creates a whole "second level" source for understanding
 - b. This also contributes at times to controversy
 - 2. With the passage of time the narrative grows
 - 3. Modern biographies can also point to similar events:

- a. Padre Pio
- b. St. Gemma, etc.
